HB 2145 Admission Requirements

Checklist for HB2145 Applicants

In order to be admitted to KCKCC under Kansas Law HB2145, an applicant must:

1. Have attended an accredited Kansas high school for three or more years AND
2. Have either graduated from an accredited Kansas high school or earned a GED issued in Kansas AND
3. in the case of a person without lawful immigration status, have signed and filed a KCKCC HB2145 Affidavit form

Steps to Admissions:

1. Complete an Application for Admission. All materials submitted become the property of KCKCC and cannot be returned. The college will not honor requests for waiver of admission requirements.

2. Complete the KCKCC HB2145 Affidavit. Submit your completed HB 2145 form and return it along with your completed KCKCC application for admission.

3. Request official copies of your transcript to be sent to KCKCC. KCKCC must receive your official high school transcript before she/he will be allowed to enroll to verify you have graduated from a Kansas high school. KCKCC must also receive official copies of your transcripts from any US colleges/universities you have attended by the end of your 1st semester.

4. Document college level skill in College Algebra and English. Skill may be documented by any one of the following:

- a. Complete the Accuplacer placement test on KCKCC's campus.
- b. Submit unofficial transcripts from a U.S. college or university documenting you have completed College Algebra with a grade of C or better and English Composition I with a grade of D or better.
